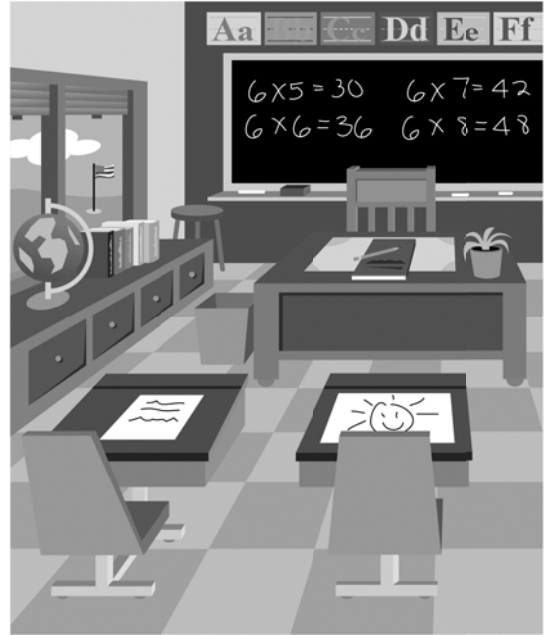


TEA New Teacher Conference
